# Columbia County Corrections IGA Amendment #6

RE: Columbia County Corrections Work Crew

Amendment #6 to Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA)

#### **Discussion**

For the past several years, the Port has been using the services of the Columbia County Community Corrections Work Crew for assistance with various outdoor cleanup task such as fence line and trail maintenance, trimming shrubs, weeding, gutter and roof cleaning, leaf raking, and other similar activities at a cost-effective rate of \$375 per day for up to 7 people. They have done impressive work, and the Port would like to continue using their services. The current IGA with the County has recently expired. Amendment #6 extends the IGA for another 2 years, changes the minimum number of clients from 4 to 3 with 18 minimum labor hours and updates contact information.

#### Recommendation

Adopt **Resolution 2025-28**, authorizing the Executive Director to execute Amendment #6 to the IGA with Columbia County and any other necessary documents.

# A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT #6 TO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH COLUMBIA COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Port of Columbia County entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with Columbia County, Oregon for the provision of supervised Community Corrections Work Crews, dated May 27, 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, the Port and the County extended the IGA with Amendments #1, #2, #3, #4 and #5 in 2016, 2017, 2018, 2020 and 2024, respectively; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties wish to further extend the IGA through June 30, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, the fee of \$375 per day acceptable and reasonable with a work crew of four (4) or more on site through 2025, and three or more through 2026; Now, therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the Port of Columbia County as follows:

The Board authorizes the Executive Director to execute the attached Amendment #6 to the Intergovernmental Agreement between Columbia County and the Port of Columbia County and any other necessary documents.

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#### AMENDMENT NUMBER SIX TO INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN COLUMBIA COUNTY, OREGON AND THE PORT OF COLUMBIA COUNTY

This Amendment Number Six is to the Intergovernmental Agreement ("Amendment") by and between Columbia County, Oregon ("County") and the Port of Columbia County ("Port") for the provision of supervised Community Corrections work crews effective May 27, 2015 ("the IGA").

WHEREAS, on May 27, 2015, the County and the Port entered into the IGA for the provision of supervised Community Corrections work crews; and

WHEREAS, effective July 1, 2016, the County and the Port entered into Amendment Number One to the IGA, extending the term through June 30, 2017; and

WHEREAS, effective July 1, 2017, the County and Port entered into Amendment Number Two to the IGA, extending the term through June 30, 2018, and increasing the compensation; and

WHEREAS, effective July 11, 2018, the County and Port entered into Amendment Number Three to the IGA, extending the term through June 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, effective June 26, 2020, the County and Port entered into Amendment Number Four to the IGA, extending the term through June 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, effective August 25, 2022, the County and Port entered into Amendment Number Five to the IGA, extending the term through June 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the term through June 30, 2026, update Liaison Responsibility, and adjust the total minimum crew hours and labor hours per day;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 7, Term of Agreement, is hereby deleted and replaced in its entirety by the following:
  - "This Amendment becomes effective on the date it is signed by the Board of Commissioners, and shall continue until June 30, 2026, unless otherwise extended upon written approval of the parties. This Agreement is subject to termination by either of the parties when thirty (30) days' written notice has been provided to the other party."
- 2. Section 2.2.2 is hereby deleted and replaced in its entirety with the following:
  - "For the period beginning July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025, the County agrees to provide a minimum of four (4) clients to perform general labor on a mutually agreed-upon schedule. Total labor hours per crew is a minimum of twenty-four (24) labor hours.

For the period beginning July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026, the County agrees to

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provide a minimum of three (3) clients to perform general labor on a mutually agreed-upon schedule. Total labor hours per crew is a minimum of eighteen (18) labor hours."

3. Section 4, Liaison Responsibility, is hereby deleted and replaced in its entirety with the following:

"Clint Lukich, Port Maintenance Supervisor, (503) 369-2602, or his designee will act as liaison from the Port for this project.

For crew scheduling, the Port should contact David Brooke, Community Services Program Coordinator, (503) 397-6253, ext. 1481."

- 4. This Amendment is effective on the date last signed below and shall be retroactive to July 1, 2024.
- 5. Except as specifically amended above, the IGA remains in full force and effect.
