WHEREAS, the Port entered into a contract with Cascadia Associates, LLC to create a Feasibility Study (FS) for the clean-up of the Railroad Avenue Industrial Park site on February 26, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2021, GeoEngineers, Inc. purchased Cascadia Associates LLC: and,

WHEREAS, the draft FS will be released shortly to DEQ for review and comment; and,

WHEREAS, as a result of the sale, Kurt Harrington, who wrote and prepared the FS, is now an employee and minority owner of GeoEngineers Inc., and the Port desires that Mr. Harrington be available to respond to DEQ's comments and questions, now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Port of Columbia County as follows:

The Board approves the attached proposal and authorizes the Executive Director to assign the agreement dated February 26, 2020, between the Port and Cascadia Associates LLC to GeoEngineers, Inc.
