**WHEREAS**, this Second Amendment expands Section 1.1 ("Use of the Premises") of the Ground Lease to allow SAF and will not change the renewable feedstocks used or the Allowed Use of the Premises; Now, therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board authorizes the Executive Director to execute the Second Amendment to Ground Lease as presented.
